This Youth meeting is the second activity of the "Green Compass for Europe" project. The aim of "Youth Going Green" is to bring together 15 youngsters from different communities, educate them, give them space and time to brainstorm and come up with the new ideas of helping their local environment to go green and teach the tools and ways of how they can implement their idea and initiatives into reality.

The working methods will be based on non-formal education activities.

Mobility goals:



- TO RAISE YOUTH AWARENESS ABOUT THE 'GREEN LIFE' AND DEMONSTRATE HOW MUCH EACH PERSON CAN DO FOR OUR ENVIRONMENT.

- TO EDUCATE YOUNG PEOPLE, GIVE THEM SPACE AND TIME TO BRAINSTORM AND COME UP WITH THE NEW IDEAS OF HELPING THEIR LOCAL ENVIRONMENT TO GO GREEN AND LIVE MORE SUSTAINABLE.

- TO ENCOURAGE YOUTH TO TAKE ACTION FOR IMPLEMENTING GREEN INITIATIVES LOCALLY IN THEIR COMMUNITIES AND CONTRIBUTE TO PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT.

- TO PROVIDE YOUTH WITH KNOWLEDGE AND EXAMPLES OF TOOLS HOW THEY CAN IMPLEMENT THEIR IDEAS AND INITIATIVES INTO REALITY

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

- Age: 18-26 years old;
- Have desire for international communication, multiculturalism, team-building and dialog;
- Ready to share experience and gain new one in multicultural environment;
- Interested in protecting the environment and sustainability topic
- **Are able to act as a multiplier in local community;**
- Committed to attend for the full duration of the project and actively participate in all follow up project activities;
- Are able to communicate in English language.
- Have experience and/or interest in video making, social media campaign or creating awareness campaigns

Nea Makri is a 50 minute drive from Athens, Greece.

Participants will be accommodated in rooms of 2-4 people (same gender) with private shower, bathroom.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE TRAVELING!

How to arrive?

We advice participants to fly to Athens airport.

Arrival is 19th March (until 17h), departure for Lithuanian and Italian participants is 25th March.

Departure for local, Greek participants, is on 24th after the end of daily activities.

TRAVEL BUDGET:

- ITALY - up to 275 Eur
- GREECE - up to 23 Eur
- LITHUANIA - up to 275 Eur



Before buying any tickets participants must get written confirmation from Asociacion "Mano Europa" staff.



REIMBURSEMENT

- Reimbursement of travel distance will be calculated using the **distance calculator**.
- Participants will be eligible to get reimbursement only if they provide original tickets, invoices, boarding passes and receipts.
- Participants must use public transport, economy class and most cost-effective journey route.
- TAXI will NOT be reimbursed in any circumstances!
- Please keep all your tickets and boarding passes as without them we can't reimburse you the money!!
- After going back home you should send us original remaining boarding passes and any other documents from return journey by post to organizer address.
- The reimbursement will be done by bank transfer to the account of partner NGO after all documents are received and follow up activities successfully implemented.
- Partner NGO is in charge to distribute the reimbursement, sent by organizer, to their participants.



HOMework BEFORE THE YOUTH MEETING:

- Participants of the Youth meeting will have homework to prepare - to organize a touch-base meeting in national teams and prepare at least 3 good examples of awareness campaigns in your countries (in relation to project topic).

DISSEMINATION AND FOLLOW UP:

- Participants who attend this Youth meeting will have to create raising awareness campaigns with the support of their sending organization after the youth mobility is finished. The awareness campaigns will be executed during the 5-11 June 2023 in your local community, therefore please make sure that you are available for this follow-up activity before deciding to participate in this youth meeting. This is a requirement.

WEATHER IN MARCH

- Weather in Athens, Greece, in March, the average high-temperature is 16°C, and the average low-temperature is 9.8°C. In any case before the Youth exchange check forecast and plan your clothes accordingly.

IMPORTANT TO KNOW:

- Some of the activities during the Youth meeting will be brainstorming and creating ideas for the development of videos aiming to educate and raise youth awareness on climate change and sustainable living. **The continuity of this activity will be done on the local level during the World Environment Week (June 5-11)** in each participating country as participants of Youth meeting will be actively involved in World Environmental Week from 5 to 11 June 2023.



WHAT TO BRING?

- European Health Insurance Card (EHIC card)
- Health insurance is mandatory to have which covers duration of your stay in Greece during mobility days.
- Personal hygiene stuff and medicines if you require any
- Comfortable shoes and clothes
- At least 1 laptop per national team

WHAT TO PREPARE?

- Intercultural night (bring or prepare something which can represent your country the best - snacks, food, drinks, traditional games, dances, BE CREATIVE!)
- Energizers
